If you or someone you know is suffering from a loss, support is available. The Bereavement Ministry of St. Thomas has printed materials on the wall, outside the kitchen in the church gathering space with phone numbers, websites and locations for online, group, or one-on-one support. Healing Journals can also be found at the back of the church.

St. Thomas Bereavement Ministry now offers, *Coffee with Friends* on the fourth Friday of each month, at 10 AM in the St. Thomas Gathering Space. Join us for coffee and connection. We understand navigating life after losing a loved one can be a challenge. Sometimes a warm cup of coffee and a safe space to share can make all the difference. Join us for this casual gathering where we come together to support one another, share stories, and find comfort. You will find a gentle, welcoming environment where you can express yourself freely or simply enjoy the companionship of others who understand your journey. Feel free to bring a friend or loved one. We hope to see you there!

In addition, St. Thomas Parish has a subscription to **FORMED**, a premiere online platform that provides essential resources to understand, live and share the Catholic faith, including those related to bereavement. You must first sign up to access this content via **Signup.formed.org**. You will be prompted to enter your full name and email address. You will receive an email message from FORMED that allows you to access materials (including audio books, videos, films) pertaining to an array of topics. To find bereavement related resources, search "Grief" or "Bereavement." Several items will appear, including **Grieving with Great Hope**, an online grief support program. As a FORMED subscriber, you have access to all five sessions of this series along with a workbook and guide.

Calming the Chaos is a Grief Support Group held at the Burlington Senior Center, 587 East State Street, Burlington, WI (Hwy 11 and W). These sessions are led by Tammy Beardsley, Grief Specialist, on Fridays from 9 to 10:30 AM. Tammy's goals and aspirations are to assist people dealing with the loss of a loved one by providing resources and emotional support as they work through their grief to find a new normal in their life. Loss of any kind is difficult to maneuver, but the most important thing to remember is you are not alone and there is no time frame for your grief.

Compassionate Friends is a mutual assistance, self-help organization offering friendship and understanding to bereaved parents and siblings. The primary purpose is to assist them in the positive resolution of the grief experienced upon the death of a child.
