



Eucharistic Procession on Corpus Christi Sunday, June 11, 2023

Details for Participants

FYI – If it is raining, this event is cancelled.

1st leg – Walking, 1.74 miles

- St. Thomas to Runzheimer's lot, thru Waterford and then along the bike trail.
- Depart St. Thomas parking lot following 11:15am Mass, at 12:15-12:30pm.
- Father Ed will lead the procession, carrying the Blessed Sacrament in a monstrance.
- Water will be provided; also a procession flag to carry and wave.
- Our prayerful witness will include common prayer of the rosary and divine chaplet, led by recorded audio.
- Approximate walk time is 35 minutes.
- At Runzheimer's lot a bus will be available to return walkers to their cars at St. Thomas.
- Please join us at St. Clare for closing benediction and ice cream social, at 2:00pm.

2nd leg – Bicycles, 3.4 miles

- Runzheimer's lot to Penny Bar along bike trail.
- Depart approximately 1:00pm.
- Father Ed will lead the procession on a golf cart, carrying the monstrance.
- Water will be provided; also a procession flag to attach to your bike.
- We will continue our prayerful witness as we pray together the rosary, led by recorded audio.
- Approximate riding time is 30 minutes.
- At the Penny Bar, bikers should dismount to walk the remaining distance along Loomis Road to St. Clare.
- A wagon will be available at the St. Clare parking lot to transport bikes back to Runzheimer's parking lot at the end of the event, about 2:30pm. A bus will transport the bikers back.

3rd leg – Walking, .9 miles

- Penny Bar to St. Clare along Loomis Road, with police escort.
- Park at St. Clare parking lot. A bus will bring walkers to Penny Bar, or they can walk down.
- Depart approximately 1:30pm
- Father Ed will lead the procession on foot, carrying the monstrance.
- Water will be provided; also a procession flag to carry and wave.
- We will continue our prayerful witness as we pray together the rosary, led by recorded audio.

Honor Guard – Non Walkers

- Runway of prayer warriors at entrance to St. Clare parking lot.
- Park at St. Clare parking lot. Be in place at 1:45pm.
- Chairs will be provided; also water and a procession flag to carry and wave.

Benediction and Ice Cream Social

- At St. Clare, Benediction in church and then downstairs to Holy Family Hall for Ice Cream Social.
- Begins at 2:00 pm
