What do I do if I am told I will miscarry?

If you are below 20 weeks pregnant and are told you will miscarry please call. Life’s Connection will supply a Miscarriage Aid Kit and a support person to guide you. You can bury your baby’s precious body and we are here to help with vital information to walk you through this difficult time. If you are over 20 weeks we have support, resources and help.

I had a stillborn baby in the past and would like some additional help?

We are sorry for your loss. Life’s Connection understands your loss. Visit us. We have various resources and memorial aids to give you hope in your time of hurt.

Life has value from conception to death and we recognize your loss is the loss of a life you looked forward to bringing into the world. We help you find hope in the midst of your grief and encourage you through your healing process.
